June 8th GRILL OFF RULES & REGULATIONS

- Teams consist of head cook and any listed members. If a team wishes to enter two entries in the same category they must enter a second team.
- 2. Grill options are outlined in entry rules.
- 3. No pre-seasoned products. All food entries must be checked upon arrival. All entries must be checked by 9AM. Teams are responsible for ensuring they have their groceries checked.
- 4. Cooking spots come with one entry category. Each additional category is \$25 each.
- 5. Who gives a CHEF category can be entered for \$50. This category will consist of each team getting a surprise brown bag with an ingredient(s) that must be featured in your turn in dish. Everyone will receive the same ingredient(s). We will meet under the pavilion at 10AM to reveal / receive the chefs surprise ingredient(s).
- 6. <u>Veggies</u> focus of the category is on the vegetable(s) it can be more than one but it all must be grilled. <u>Pork</u> any type of pork meat is allowed. A sauce, coating, condiment is allowed to enhance the flavor. <u>Beef</u> any type of beef is allowed. A sauce, coating, condiment is allowed for flavor enhancement. <u>Open</u> just as it states any category of the cook's choosing but must be grilled. This includes fruits, vegetables, meats, seafood or dessert. <u>Example</u> guacamole with fajitas, or grilled onions/peppers with fajitas the focus is the meat but the guac, onions/peppers enhance the flavor of the meat. Only one type of enhancement allowed.
- 10. There should be at least enough food turned in to feed 10 iudges.
- 11. Containers can be lined to protect/maintain flavors, but it is up to the individual teams.
