Rules & Regulations

1. To participate, return the entry form to the Chamber office with payment no later than **June 5, 2024 (Checks made payable to Brazoria Chamber of Commerce)**
2. Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-serve basis and will be assigned by the Chamber.
3. Payment must be received in full to reserve booth space.
4. Limited spaces for the same type of product. There will be no duplications of food products.
5. **Food / Vendor Event Schedule - Saturday, 9:00 - 5:00 p.m.**
 - **SET UP TIME** – vendors can start setting up Saturday, June 8th at 7:00 a.m. and must be set up by 9:00 a.m. and teardown at 5:00 p.m. Vehicles will not be permitted to enter the area for teardown or setup except for allotted times given.
6. **NO EARLY SETUP OR TEAR DOWN TIMES**
7. Vendors will not be permitted to close down booth until Saturday at 5:00 p.m.
8. Booths with electricity cannot use items that require more than 20 amps (if you require more than 20 amps you will need to provide your own power source).
9. No vendor will be allowed to sell their merchandise outside the assigned area.
10. **BOOTHS & CHILDREN** must always be attended.
11. If expelled for any reason, there will be **no refunds. NO REFUNDS** for any reason, no exceptions.
12. **All food vendors** are required to purchase a temporary health certificate. The permit is available through the Brazoria County health department. **(Health dept. phone: 979-864-1600).**
13. **Please provide an email to receive information about event.**
14. Event location: 202 W. Smith St.–Brazoria, TX 77422 (Brazoria Civic Center & Museum grounds)
15. Vendors may pay the day of the festival for the following year to secure their spots.

PROHIBITED ITEMS
